Get ready for POKR 2025—our 16th retreat! The years just keep adding up. Here are the details for this year's event.

Attendance is limited to 85, an increase from last year. We are happy to include a few more while still keeping that crowded feeling under control.

Pre-registration is REQUIRED. We cannot handle cash, checks, cards or Venmo, etc, at the door.

To register, complete the form below and return it by March 8th with your check or money order for \$15 made payable to Ann Marshall. We will let you know that we have received your registration, either by email or postcard, if you don't have email.

Seating remains the same as last year. Please sit on the LEFT side of all tables, leaving the entire RIGHT side available for stash sale items. You may bring your surplus stash to sell, including yarn, unspun fiber, knitting needles and tools, and patterns. (Please, no commercial sales or finished items). Space for stash is limited, so plan accordingly! A Free Table will be centrally located for give-away items.

Please note: We will miss Sheila Joynes, our in-house knitting designer and guru; she is unable to attend this year; no classes will be held.

Please bring a brown-bag lunch as you always have. Coffee, tea, and hot water will be available at no charge. Although POKR provides disposable cups we encourage you to bring your own mug. The Snack Table will be set up as usual at the kitchen window. Members of POKR's supporting group (the Port Orchard Knitters) will provide tasty and sometimes even healthy treats—keep your energy up for this day of knitting and help yourself to snacks!
